

# Retention and Completion: Undergraduate Transfer Students UGA Fall Cohorts 2000 – 2009

#### **Summary**

This report summarizes the retention and completion rates for the University of Georgia (UGA) transfer student cohorts, 2000-2009. Transfer student cohorts are defined as students who enrolled full-time at UGA in the respective cohort-year fall term after previously attending another institution. Two transfer student groups are tracked, students who entered UGA at the sophomore and junior student level. Completion is defined as a student having graduated with a bachelor's degree or matriculated into a professional program at UGA (ex: Pharmacy & Veterinary Medicine). Retention is defined as a student having enrolled the following fall term; who matriculated into a professional program at UGA; or who graduated with a bachelor's degree. Students are counted as graduated through the summer term (cumulative). Due to small numbers of students in some race/ethnic categories, it should be noted that retention and graduation rate comparisons by race/ethnicity should be interpreted with caution.

The percentage of UGA transfer students returning for their second year (second year retention) has risen from 88.1% for transfer sophomores and 89.6% for transfer juniors for the 2000 cohort to 91.5% for transfer sophomores and 91.8% for transfer juniors for the 2009 cohort (see Table 1). Both transfer junior and transfer sophomore students were retained at lower rates than freshman cohort students after the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year. However, transfer students "caught up" to freshman cohort students and in general, had higher yearly completion rates.

Similar to freshman cohort students, male transfer students were generally retained to the second year at higher rates than female transfer students. For transfer sophomores, in general, females completed at a higher rate in the first three years, but males had higher completion rates for years four through six. This suggests that transfer sophomore females are finishing their undergraduate studies quicker, but transfer sophomore males are more likely to complete. For transfer juniors, the trend in the cohorts of this study showed that females completed at higher rates than males at all yearly marks. The three yearly averages (3, 5, and 10-year; tables 6, 8, 14, & 16) by gender show these patterns holding for retention and completion throughout the last few years.

The latest cohort (2009) examined shows that transfer junior students of Black/African-American, Native American, and White race/ethnicity had higher second year retention rates than cohort mean (91.8%). For transfer sophomores, students of Hispanic, Native American, and White race/ethnicity had higher second year retention rates than the cohort mean (91.5%). The latest cohort (2009) examined also shows resident students having higher second year retention rates than non-resident students for transfer juniors, but for transfer sophomores, non-resident students had a higher second year retention rate than resident students.

Tables 5-8 present second year retention rates by gender

- Tables 6 and 8 present the latest 3, 5, and 10-year averages of retention by gender
  - o In both tables 6 and 8, males have a slightly (1-2 point) higher second year retention rates than females

Tables 9-12 present second year retention rates by race/ethnicity<sup>1</sup>

- Tables 11 and 12 present the latest 3, 5, and 10-year averages of retention by race/ethnicity
  - o Table 11 (transfer juniors) shows for the last 3 years, Black/African-American, Native American, Multi-racial, and White students having higher second year retention rates than the 3-year mean (91.1%)
  - o Table 12 (transfer sophomores) shows for the last 3 years, Black/African-American, Hispanic, and White students having higher second year retention rates than the 3-year mean (90.3%)

### Tables 13-16 present completion rates by gender

- Tables 14 and 16 present the latest 3 and 5-year averages of 4 and 6-year completion rates by gender
  - o Table 14 (transfer juniors) shows for the last 3 years (2002-2004 cohorts), females (84.8%) have a higher 6-year completion rates than males (80.9)
  - o Table 16 (transfer sophomores) shows for the last 3 years (2002-2004 cohorts), males (83.7%) have a higher 6-year completion rate than females (78.0%)

## Tables 17-20 present completion rates by race/ethnicity

- Tables 18 and 20 present the latest 3 and 5-year averages of 4 and 6-year completion rates by race/ethnicity
  - o Table 18 (transfer juniors) shows for the last 3 years (2002-2004 cohorts), Black/African-American, Hispanic, Native American, and White students have higher 6-year completion rates than the 3 year mean (82.8%)
  - Table 20 (transfer sophomores) shows for the last 3 years (2002-2004 cohorts), White students have higher 6-year completion rates than the 3-year mean (80.6%)

#### Tables 21-24 present second year retention rates by residency

- Tables 22 and 24 present the latest 3, 5, and 10-year averages of second year retention by residency
  - o Both table 22 (transfer juniors) and table 24 (transfer sophomores) show that resident students are retained at higher rates than non-resident
  - o The difference in second year retention rates between resident and non-resident students has been decreasing the last few years (based on the 3 and 5-year averages)

# Tables 25-28 present completion rates by residency

- Tables 26 and 28 present the latest 3 and 5-year averages of 4 and 6-year completion rates by residency
  - o Tables 26 (transfer juniors) and table 28 (transfer sophomore) show that resident students complete at higher rates (4 and 6-year) than non-resident students
  - o The difference in 6-year completion rates between resident and non-resident students has been increasing the last few years (based on the 3 and 5-year averages)

Figure1: Second Year Retention Rates



Figure 2: Completion Rates – 2004 cohorts







Figure 3: Completion Rates – Transfer Juniors




