



**Summary Report of Retention and Completion Rates  
UGA First-Time Full-Time Freshman  
Cohorts 2000 - 2009**

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### Summary

This report summarizes the retention and completion rates for UGA first-time full-time freshman cohorts, 2000-2009. Freshman cohorts are defined as first-time students who entered in the respective summer or fall terms and were full-time students in the cohort-year fall term (consistent with IPEDS and BOR definitions). Completion is defined as a student graduated with a bachelor's degree or matriculated into a professional program at UGA (ex: Pharmacy & Veterinary Medicine). Retention is defined as a student enrolled the following fall term; who matriculated into a professional program at UGA; or who graduated with a bachelor's degree. Students are counted as graduated through the summer term (cumulative). Due to small numbers of students in some ethnic and housing categories, it should be noted that retention and completion rate comparisons by these categories should be interpreted with caution.

The percentage of UGA first-time full-time freshman returning for their 2<sup>nd</sup> year has risen from 91.5% for the 2000 cohort to 94.4% for the most recent freshman class (2009 cohort, see Table 1). 83.2% of the 2004 cohort was retained through six years, up from the previous cohort (2003) of 83.0%.

The six-year completion rate for the 2004 cohort was 81.5%, up from 80.8% for the 2003 cohort and 77.3% for the 2000 cohort (see Table 2). The four-year completion rate for the 2006 cohort was 55.2%, which is roughly equal to the previous cohort (2005, 55.3%) and up from the 2000 cohort rate of 46.9%.

Tables 4-7 present retention rates by gender and race/ethnicity

- For the 2009 cohort, females (94.5%) were retained to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year at a slightly higher rate than males (94.3%)
  - Table 5 shows that males though, when looking at the latest 3-year, 5-year, and 10-year averages, have had slightly retention rates to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year than females over time
- For the 2009 cohort, a higher percentage of Non-White/Caucasian freshman were retained to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year than White/Caucasian (93.9%) freshman
  - Table 7 shows this pattern holding mostly true over time, when looking at the latest 3-year, 5-year, and 10-year averages, as Asian, Black-African American, and Hispanic students were retained to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year at higher rates than White/Caucasian students

Tables 8-11 present completion rates by gender and race/ethnicity<sup>1</sup>

- In general, females complete at higher rates than males with largest difference at the 4-year mark
  - The latest 4-year rates (2006 cohort) show that females (59.1%) had a 10.5% higher completion rate than males (48.6%)
  - The latest 6-year rates (2004 cohort) show that females (82.5%) had 2.4% higher completion rate than males (80.1%)
  - Table 9 shows that females, when looking at the latest 3-year, 5-year, and 10-year averages, have at higher completion rates than males over time at the 4-year, 5-year, and 6-year marks
- For the 2004 cohort, Black/African-Americans (81.0%), Hispanic (85.9%), Native American (90.0%), and White/Caucasian students (81.6%) had 6-year completion rates higher than 80%
- For the 2006 cohort, Asian (55.7%), Hispanic (50.0%), Native American (77.8%), Multi-racial (51.6%), and White/Caucasian (56.4%) students had 4-year completion rates at 50% or higher.
  - Table 11 shows that Asian, Native American, and White/Caucasian students, when looking at the latest 3-year and 5-year averages, have higher 4-year completion rates than total student average
  - Table 11 shows that students from all race/ethnicities, when looking at the latest 3-year averages, have 6-year completion rates over 75%

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<sup>1</sup> In summer 2009, UGA updated race/ethnicity definitions to meet new IPEDS/U.S. Department of Education guidelines. Students in cohorts previous to 2009 were not changed to keep historical comparison aspects.

Tables 12 and 13 present retention rates by student housing choice in 1<sup>st</sup> semester.

- In general, students who live on-campus in their 1<sup>st</sup> semester have higher retention rates than students who live off-campus
- For 2009 cohort, there was a 14.5% difference in the retention rate (to 2<sup>nd</sup> year) between students who live-on campus 1<sup>st</sup> semester (94.7%) and off-campus (80.2%)
  - Table 13 shows that the difference in the rates of students retained to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, when looking at the latest 3-year (17.5%) and 5-year (16.7%) averages have grown over time

Tables 14-17 present retention and completion rates by residency

- In general, Georgia resident students are retained at higher rates than non-resident students
  - For the 2009 cohort, the difference in the rate of students being retained to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year was 5.6% (95.1% Georgia residents, 89.5% non-residents)
  - Table 15 shows that the difference in the rates of students retained to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, when looking at the latest 3-year, 5-year, and 10-year averages has remained fairly stable (around 5%)
- Non-resident students have higher 4-year completion rates than resident students, but resident and non-resident students have comparable 6-year completion rates.
  - Table 17 shows that non-resident students have higher 4-year completion rates, when looking at the latest 3-year and 5-year averages than resident students
  - Table 17 shows that Georgia resident students have slightly higher, but fairly comparable 6-year completion rates, when looking at the latest 3-year and 5-year averages than non-resident students

Tables 18-21 present retention and completion rates by receipt of the HOPE scholarship in 1<sup>st</sup> term

- Students who receive HOPE in 1<sup>st</sup> term are retained at higher rates than students who do not receive HOPE in 1<sup>st</sup> term.
  - Table 19 shows that students who receive HOPE in the 1<sup>st</sup> term, when looking at the latest 3-year, 5-year, and 10-year averages, are retained at roughly a 5% higher rate than students who do not receive HOPE in the 1<sup>st</sup> term
- In general, students who do not receive HOPE in the 1<sup>st</sup> term have higher 4-year completion rates than students who did receive HOPE in 1<sup>st</sup> term, but students who received HOPE in 1<sup>st</sup> term had higher 6-year completion rates than students who did not receive HOPE in 1<sup>st</sup> term
  - Table 21 shows that students who did not receive HOPE in 1<sup>st</sup> term completed at higher rates at the 4-year mark, when looking at the latest 3-year and 5-year averages, than students who did receive HOPE in their 1<sup>st</sup> term
  - Table 21 shows that students who received HOPE in 1<sup>st</sup> term completed at higher rates at the 6-year mark, when looking at the latest 3-year and 5-year averages, than students who did not receive HOPE in their 1<sup>st</sup> term

Figure1: Retention Rates

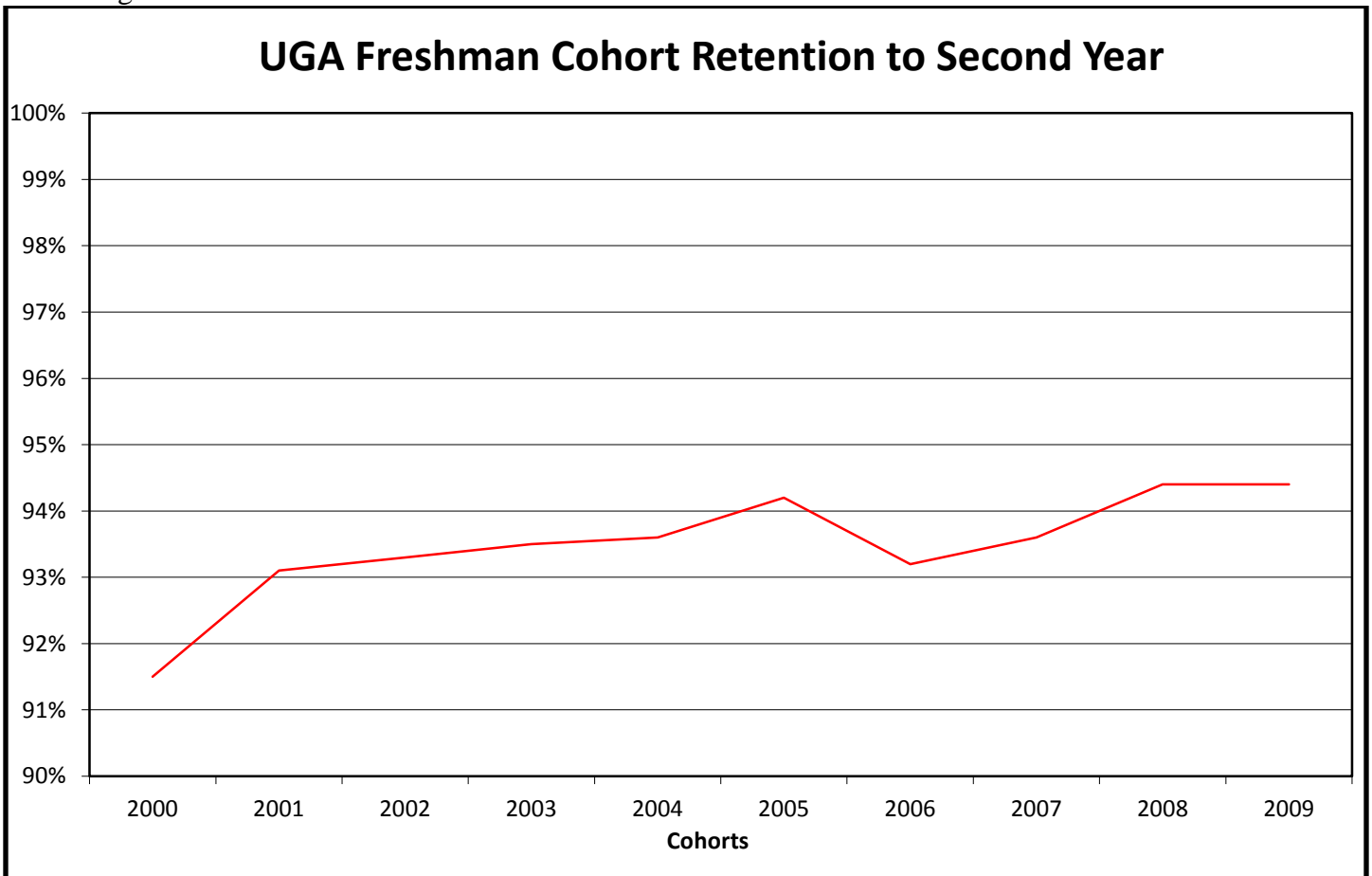

Figure 2: Completion Rates

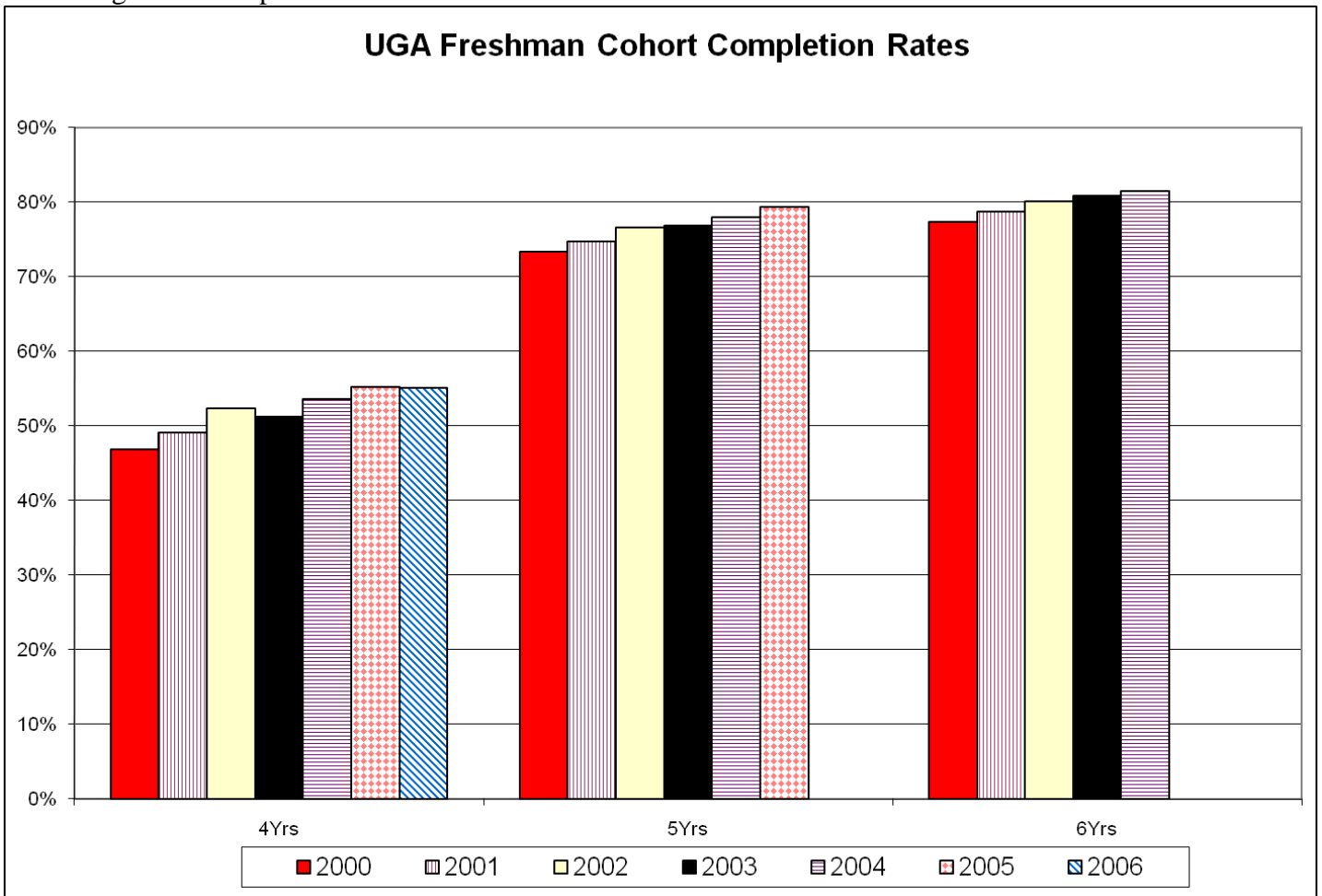
